Inaugural NC Transportation Summit

Last week, more than 1,000 registered people converged in Raleigh for NCDOT's first-ever [NC Transportation Summit](#), titled, *Moving from Vision to Reality at the Speed of Change*. The summit invited transportation industry leaders from around the world to discuss the future of transportation, economic and environmental challenges, emerging technologies and more.

Companies who are leaders in game-changing technologies discussed their ideas and showcased groundbreaking technologies. The two-day event was an opportunity for NCDOT to begin developing a long-range plan for building and funding the most comprehensive modern transportation system in the nation.



The Draft 2020-29 STIP Is Released



A final draft of the department's transportation plan for 2020-2029 is out. The plan has over 1,600 projects covering the entire state and all modes of transportation.

Division 13 has 16 new projects, including:

- Modernizing North Louisiana from Patton Avenue to Emma Road in Buncombe County with right of way acquisition starting in fiscal year 2025 and construction in 2026;
- Widening N.C. 226 from U.S. 221 to N.C. 226A in McDowell County with right of way acquisition starting in fiscal year 2029;

- Improving the intersection of U.S. 221 with Thunder Road and Coxe Road in Rutherford County with right of way acquisition starting in fiscal year 2024 and construction in 2025.
- Upgrade U.S. 25/70 from Tillery Branch Road to Monticello Road in Madison County with right of way acquisition starting in fiscal year 2029.
